They will meet you at the McDonald's located at the intersection of Interstate 90 and Ohio route 534 (Geneva exit) at 10 o'clock AM on Saturday Oct 16th. The latest weather forecasts indicate that fall colors will continue into late October this year, so this is a great opportunity to drive through some of Northeast Ohio's most beautiful countryside.

Our caravan will depart from McDonald's at 10:15 a.m. for a scenic drive through Ashtabula County. Our group will visit twelve covered bridges including the shortest and longest covered bridges in the United States, a pedestrian covered bridge, and the oldest covered bridge in the US. There will be stops along the way where you can stretch, socialize, and use the facilities.
